

## **Guidelines for Overseas Mission Teams Partnering with Tokyo Baptist Church**

(March 28, 2012)

- Tokyo Baptist Church partners with churches from overseas that desire to send mission teams to Tokyo for the purpose of evangelism-sharing the good news of Jesus Christ.

Expectations from the Mission Teams:

- (1) Every person in the mission team must be a born-again baptized believer and a member of an evangelical church.
  - (2) The mission team members must come with a servant attitude and a willingness to reach people for Christ.
  - (3) The mission team members must pay for necessary accommodation, food and transportation expenses for the duration of the trip.
  - (4) The mission team members must come with their travel medical insurance that covers the entire period of stay.
  - (5) The mission team members must meet all the qualifications required by their church prior to arrival.

And we would really appreciate if you could provide us the following information:
    - (1) Name of the Sending Church and its Affiliation or Denomination
    - (2) Name of the Mission Team Leader and Contact Info
    - (3) Names, Ages, Genders, Marital Status and Nationalities of the Team Members
    - (4) Size of the Team; Number of Adult Men and Women, Teenagers, Couples
    - (5) Reason/s for Coming
    - (6) Estimated Date of Arrival and Departure
    - (7) Specific Mission and Ministry Activities the Mission Team Can Do
    - (8) Does the mission team plan to arrange its accommodation and local transportation? Where does the mission team plan to stay?
    - (9) Expectations that you might have from Tokyo Baptist Church
